



## KICKSTART - USEFUL INFORMATION

**Fuel local** - Sutton Valence 1 mile, Headcorn 2 miles and Staplehurst 1.5 miles

**Supplies** - Staplehurst -Spa and Headcorn - Local Sainsburys

Garages as above for ciggies and sundries

### **Suggested Rides:**

1066 Café, Robertsbridge A21 TN32 5DH – popular bikers café, 17 miles

Rye Quay Car Park TN31 7DA - popular bikers meeting place with café and chippy, 22 miles

Oasis Café- Old Romney TN29 9SG – Popular bikers café, 23 miles

Headcorn Aerodrome, Headcorn TN27 9HX – Air Warfare Museum (entry£2) Café, Wings Bar , WW II aircraft flying , 4.2 miles

These routes are suggested as places you might like as destinations, with roads to include bendy bits and good straights . Mileage is one way from the Hawkenbury .

Please ride safely and considerately and be aware of potholes, tractors, combine harvesters and escaped pigs on corners ( ask Donna and Jim for this one 😊 )

### **Housekeeping**

Entry for campers and vehicles – register at the Hawkenbury first. Please read the campers information sheet which will be given to you , regarding traffic movements and safety matters etc .
